Getting around in Fribourg

Walking:

Fribourg is a small and beautiful town that offers many pleasant walks. A recommended walking route between the city center, the train station and the colloquium location is marked on the attached map by blue dots. This route is relatively flat, but you should keep in mind that Fribourg is a three-dimensional city and some distances might be longer than they appear on a map.

Bus:

During daytime, buses run very frequently. Check on <u>www.tpf.ch</u> for lines and schedules. A bus ticket (zone 10, adult) costs 2,80 CHF.

You have to buy it before boarding the bus at the vending machine close to every bus stop. The ticket is valid for one hour.

Alternatively, you can buy an SMS ticket by texting "10" to the number 873.

Recommended bus stops are marked on the map by a red arrow:

- Charmettes for the conference;
- St Pierre for the conference dinner.

Conference location:

The conference will take place in the Physics building (PER 08) in room 2.73 (on the second floor). The full adress is "Physics department / Chemin du Musée, 3 / CH-1700 Fribourg".
